Join us for an evening of environmental ideas, discussion, art and music! This free event features a public talk by Gwynne Dyer, political columnist and author of ***Climate Wars***, followed by a book signing, live music by Sherman Downey, and an art exhibit by Grenfell visual arts faculty Pierre Le Blanc, David Morrish, and Kent Jones.

**Green Books** is an exciting new initiative of the developing Environmental Policy Institute (EPI) at Sir Wilfred Grenfell College. It is the province's first environmental book club and the EPI's first major community debate facilitation activity. The project aims to engage communities in conversations on cutting-edge and highly-acclaimed books that explore environmental issues impacting the province. ***Climate Wars*** by Gwynne Dyer has been selected as the first Green Book for 2009-2010. Copies of the book have been donated to all 96 public libraries across the province, as well as other libraries in the Corner Brook area such as the College of the North Atlantic and Natural Resources Canada, and local coffee shops.

The EPI's main objective is to research and facilitate debate on environmental policy issues within the province of Newfoundland and Labrador. This includes analyzing current environmental policies, exploring innovative solutions, disseminating this research widely to both academic and general public audiences and developing capacity in the environmental policy field in the province.

**Green Books** and the Green Books launch are supported by Sir Wilfred Grenfell College, the Centre of Environmental Excellence, Newfoundland and Labrador Public Libraries and The Western Star.
